He is also Registrar of Intellectual Property, Foundations, and responsible for LPs, the registration of LLPs and maintains the Registers of Recognised Auditors, Charities and Not-for Profit organisations, in addition to his most recent appointment as Registrar under the Beneficial Ownership of Legal Persons (Guernsey) Law, 2017.

Alan achieved his UMIST BSc (Hons) in Financial Services through the Guernsey Business School and his Bournemouth University MSc in Corporate Governance through the GTA University Centre. He is also a Chartered Director. He is a former Chairman of the Association of Guernsey Banks, former Deputy Chairman of Guernsey International Business Association and former trustee of the GTA.
